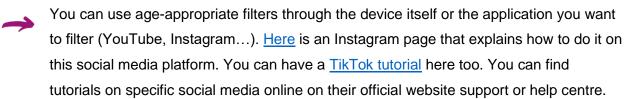


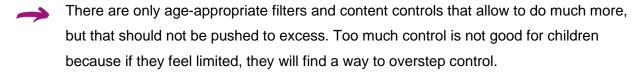
Why is this important?

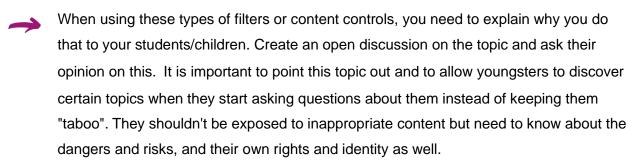

Sometimes because they are too violent, too scary, or just unwanted. This kind of content can be a risk to their mental health. They can develop traumatism because of violent or scary content or be influenced by the wrong people and have behavioural issues.
